

The Government of Ontario announced that the province would move to Step 3 of the Reopening Ontario plan. This is fantastic news for the Association because The Seniors Centre is a Step 3 facility. I'm excited to let you know that **The Centre will reopen on Monday July 19** with the following measures in place:

- Masks are still required indoors.
- Six-foot distancing must be maintained. Class sizes will be limited to comply with this regulation. Seating in Rendezvous Café and Hatter's Cove will be limited to a reduced number of tables (four people/table).
- This month, *Vista* and the Fall Program Guide will be delivered by our volunteers. If you have chosen to pick up your *Vista* at The Centre, you can do that once again. If you always receive *Vista* by mail (Canada Post), you will need to pick up the new Guide at The Centre or check our website www.SeniorsKingston.ca (beginning Monday July 19). Program Guides cannot be mailed.
