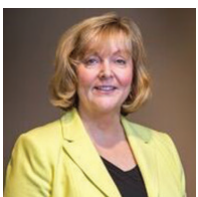
SLATE OF NOMINEES

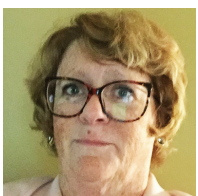

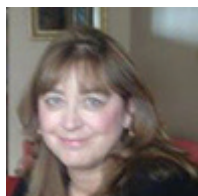

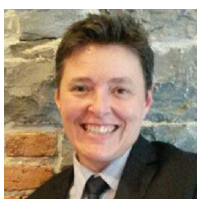
administration, and worked with the Ministry of Health and Long Term care. Alexis joined the Association in 2017 as an active member and committee member of the Fundraising Committee.
